remain dry elsewhere over the country. Rain and shower occured at a few places over Chittagong division including Chittagong city. Dry weather prevailed elsewhere in the country.



17,956 candidates in JU Honours admission tests By JU Correspondent


A total of 17,956 candidates are seeking admission into 19
