Sri Lanka and Bhutan arrived in the capital yesterday to take part in the South Asian Football Federation (SAFF) Championship.


The Sri Lankans reached the city via Bangkok in the afternoon while Bhutan came by road.

to lose the series in a whirlwind 11 playing days before exerting pressure in the fourth Melbourne Test, Nasser Hussain's tourists saved their best until last to outplay the Australians. Buttressed by Michael Vaughan's

However, a spokesman for the Australian Foreign Minister said the murder emphasised the government's concerns about Zimbabwe staging World Cup matches.

He also re-iterated calls for a collective boycott of all World Cup fixtures in Zimbabwe because of the policies of President Robert Mugabe and the worsening security situation
