Torture on newsmen 8 including Kalaroa **Jubo Dal leaders** chargesheeted

The accused included Ashraf Hossain, Presdient, Kalaroa Upazila Jubo Dal, General Secrtary Abdul Kadar Bachchu and Jubo Dal activists Ripon, Ranju, Raihan, Jahid, Lucky and Juhurul Islam.
