Bangladesh skipper Khaled Mashud is all set to guit the captaincy after the World Cup in South Africa, but not before helping his team end a record sequence of defeats.

"We just hope to win a couple of matches in the World Cup," said Mashud, whose team is winless since the last World Cup in England in 1999 having suffered a record 26 consecutive defeats in one-dayers.

Mashud said he is confident he has the team to fulfil their limited ambitions as they could beat non-Test playing nations, and group rivals, Canada and Kenya to end the losing streak in his first and last Bangladesh are clubbed with


