
Jimit Jimit Juni Jwaley Collected Chakma songs by Alpana





The dominant idea behind the project is to reconstruct a true national history by producing a series of local history studies based on scientific research Besides, one of the important objectives of the project is to bring out the variety in the local history and tradition as well as the diversity in culture and heritage of different regions of Bangladesh that have made the land unique and beautiful. The 62 articles included in the book show the varied characteristics of the Sylhet region.




