"Britto" workshop artists speak their minds



India, one of the participants of the Britto International Artists' Workshop, said, "When we went to Tepantar, a film city, I got the idea to make a film 'Tepantarer Rupkotha'. It is only recently that I'm involved in including film making in my work. I feel that this is an extension of my major language and I use a lot of body language and movements to express what I have to say. I have done a major video installation an other short films. I took the participants of the workshop as my heroes and heroines. As I went along, if a person was a hero at one point, in the next scene he could be a villain, as I felt that we play a lot of roles in our lives. In my film there are love scenes, separation scenes, etc. I created situations where the artists became actors and actresses. I made them dance, sing, do love scenes, have scenes of despair. I thought out the film and the artists enacted them. For the artists to stand in front of the camera and act was very difficult. This coming together, without fears and embarrassment. was like a therapy although the film has no story line. The whole camp was about experi-

product. Originally Shakuntala used to do graphics and water colours and gradually around 1994 she began



to do installations, using various items such as cloth, canvas, wood, moving around Bombay, Delhi, Bangalore, and also worked in UK for five months, doing interactive mentation and not about any final work with the community. I wanted a cultural and artistic exchange with other people of different parts of the world. Triangle Arts Trust had asked her if she wanted to take part in the Britto Workshop and that's how she came to Bangladesh. At first she spent a lot of time in making drawings. She had bought many sieves and was stitching through them and made dolls with them using fabric and wool. "I was at first apprehensive about being thrown together with people from different cultures but it turned out to be incredibly easy," said Freddie, "I had so much in common with so many people that it amazed me. Normally I work with knitted stuff which speak of normality and conformity.

Roohi Shafi Ahmed from Pakistan has done sculptures and is now doing two dimensional works. In the workshop she did installations and sculpture. At "Britto" she did two installations and a sculpture: one was about her reaction to bamboo and she tried to make a space within the larger space in which they were. The one was symbolic for her as regards the relationship between Bangladesh and Pakistan: she built

a connection between the main land and an island, using a lot of ropes and the theme was connection. Roohi said that felt totally at ease coming to Bangladesh and her only shortcoming was that she could not speak the local language.

Awena Cozannet from France said. "I wanted to do some work for women and I made a dress and added a hat to it. In the red and pink colours that I had used I represented women for the women that I saw me wore bright hued clothes." Awena had been doing a lot of installation work back in France lately

Tayaba Ali Lipi, who organized the workshop, said, "There were nine participants from outside including from Pakistan, India,

Myanmar, Indonesia, Hong Kong, UK, France, Germany, Japan. There were ten artists from Bangladesh. We went to Bhalukai. I myself worked on photographs in which I represented myself in different ays.

Carl Reuter, Director of the British Council, said at the concluding function that the workshop had been a wonderful concept where the participants offered each other artistic stimulation which took place across social boundaries. He said that art tends to be devalued in contemporary society as something peripheral, commenting that "artists are often lonely and poor and are

considered by society as something out of the mainstream.
