The arrival of Radomir Antic as Barcelona's new coach made only a minimal difference to the fortunes of the Catalan giant as they squandered a two-goal lead to finish 2-2 against Athletic Bilbao on Sunday.

The result at the Nou Camp ended Barca's three-game losing streak but still leaves them in 15th place in the Spanish first division, their lowest ever position, and only two points above the relegation

zone. Barca were two up after just 11 minutes with goals from Javier

Saviola and Marc Overmars. However, Athletic tightened up at the back and thwarted Bracelona for

the rest of the first half before getting quickly back on level terms after the break Santiago Ezquerro got one back

for the Basques from the penalty spot after 49 minutes after new signing Juan Pablo Roman had brought down Tiko Martinez.

Five minutes later, Francisco Yeste equalised for Athletic after Tiko's free kick had bounced off three players before falling at his feet.

At the top of the table, Real Sociedad saw their lead dwindle to just two points after a goalless draw with relegation-threatened Espanyol

The Basques have 44 points from 21 games, two ahead of Real Madrid who beat Real Betis 4-1 on Saturday.

"Espanyol kept us under control for the entire game but we slipped up, pure and simple," reflected Sociedad's French coach Raynald Denoueix

Sociedad's best chance came when Darko Kovacevic headed against the crossbar just a minute after half-time.

Espanyol coach Javier Clemente, whose team have only lost once in seven games since he took over in December, preferred to look forward.

"Next week, we are at home in the derby (against Barcelona) and three points there will go a long way to getting us out of danger," said the former Spain coach.

On Sunday, the ECB who have exhausted all official attempts at getting their Harare fixture moved to main hosts South Africa, handed a dossier to International Cricket Council (ICC) chiefs which they said contained new security information. That dossier has been passed to South Africa's second highest ranking police officer, Andre Pruis

who is due to provide an assessment to the ICC later Monday. However, as Zimbabwe are

adamantly opposed to relocating the fixture, England must either play the match in Harare or risk losing four World Cup points as well as incurring a fine for failing to honour their contractual obligations.

It appears now they are pinning their hopes on World Cup chiefs calling off the game and awarding both sides two points. But that would represent a huge U-turn on the part of the game's rulers.
