Atletico Madrid president Jesus Gil was sentenced to three-and-a-half years in jail and ordered to pay a fine of over 16 million euros (\$17.27 million) after being found guilty of misappropriation of funds and fraud by Spain's high court.

Gil will not have to serve the prison sentence while he still has the right to appeal to Spain's supreme court, a source at the high court told Reuters on Friday.

He will lose control of the club at least in the short term, though, after being told to hand over to the court his 267,000 Atletico Madrid shares, which make up around 95 percent of the club.

is one of the few referees ever to disallow a Golden Goal winner when he ruled against a Stefan Kuntz header against England in the semi-final a few days earlier. Germany eventually won the game


