
The Ripper




Thirty Years of **Bangladesh Politics**

Bangladesh experienced rapid liberalisation in the early 1990s, which in turn encouraged growth. There was a significant surge in exports, by a factor four, led by the garments sector. GDP grew at an annual rate of about 5 per cent. In the garment export industry, women gained access to the modern manufacturing sector in large numbers for the first time, securing 80-90% of the new jobs created. However, this impressive growth was also accompanied by growing inequalities and vulnerability in the face of increasing global competition.




