Real Madrid hung onto their place at the top of the Spanish first division after a scrappy 1-1 draw with bitter rivals Barcelona on Saturday as the title race was thrown wide open.

After having a six point lead two weeks ago, Real's advantage, which diminished with their 4-2 defeat at Real Sociedad a week ago, could be down to just one point by the end of Sunday night.

Real have 61 points from their 30 games with Deportivo La Coruna and Real Sociedad four points adrift in second and third respectively but the chasing pair both play on Sunday. Deportivo are at home to Sevilla
