A court here on Saturday sentenced eight people to life term

imprisonment in a murder case. Another accused, Gulam, was awarded one year rigorous imprisonment (RI)

Additional District Judge GMS Farid found the nine guilty and pronounced the judgement. He acquitted eight others as charges brought against them were not proved.

The convicts are Mofizul, Shamsur Rahman, Sohrab, Kamrul, Lablu Sarder, Ruhul Amin, Alim Uddin and Fazlul Huq.

All the nine are inhabitants of village Kudakati in Assassuni upazila According to the prosecution,

the convicts swooped on Zobaidul Haq, son of Mokbul Hossain of village Khanihati in the same upazila on March 4, 1995 and stabbed him. The victim was admitted to Satkhira hospital and later shifted to the Dhaka Medica College Hospital where he died on March 21.

The victim's father filed a murder case with Assassuni police station accusing 17 people.
