Two persons have been arrested as suspects in the murder of Habibur Rahman, a BNP leader and chairman of Baintala Union Parishad in Rampal upazila in Bagerhat district. They are Zafar and Akram.

Habibur Rahman, was gunned down by unidentified assailants when he was returning home Monday night along with two others

- Shaheen and Moslem. According to eye witnesses, the killers were wearing black masks

and carrying sown off rifles. Sources said the murder was sequel to intra-party rivalry. Police refused to comment, asking for more time to dig into the matter.

Local people said that the slain UP chairman played a vital role against criminals and toll collectors irrespective of their party affiliation. He was vocal against shrimp cultivation at the cost of paddy cultivation, local people said Habibur Rahman was elected

No let up in push-in bid by BSF

The Border Security Force (BSF) of India in the last 48 hours ending on Tuesday made several push-in attempts at different points on Bangladesh's north-western border by adopting new tactics.

BDR along with the frontier people foiled all the attempts, official sources said here Tension is simmering along the

whole north-western border as the BSF, with reinforcements increased its push-in bid. BDR is preparing for a flag meeting with BSF to ease the tension, the sources added.

The BSF tried to push six Bengali-speaking Indians through the remote Shaljhore border under Bhurungamari upazila in Kurigram district on Monday night.

As BDR personnel and loca people resisted, BSF forced the Indians to keep sitting on the zero the BDR said several hundred line for hours. Finally, they took Bengali-speaking Indians, mostly them back Tuesdav morning. Sources said the six were party bled by BSF in bordering Indian

One killed, 3 **Public Safety** injured in Tribunal settles **Barisal road** 385 cases in Ctg accidents

The Public Safety Tribunal of Chittagong has set a record by settling 385 cases out of 548 during the last three years.

Judge A N M Bashirullah delivered verdicts of all cases from April 2000 to April 2003 during his 33 working months

This was stated in a fact-finding report jointly written by president and secretary of the Chittagong sadar chapter of Bangladesh Society for the Enforcement of Human Rights Advocate Zia Habib Ahsan and Advocate Mohammad Sharifuddin.

The report said that a total of 548 cases were filed with the Tribunal and the court settled 385 cases during the period. Among the unsettled cases, the Higher Court stayed 63 cases while 100 cases were pending for the disposal.

The Tribunal recorded statements of 3,816 witnesses during the period

In total 1,673 Ansar-VDP mem bers won the elections.

Robber beaten to death

UNB, Chittagong

An alleged robber was beaten to death by a mob after being caught by villagers following a robbery at Dakkhin Kanchona in Satkania upazila early yesterday, police said. The victim was identified as

Omar Faruq, 30, of Bakalia in Chittagong city.

Three people also sustained bullet injuries as others in the gang opened fire on the villagers during a clash.

Police said the predawn clash occurred as a gang of nine robbers were fleeing after robbing two houses in the village. Villagers chased the robbers when Imam of a local mosque alerted them over loudspeaker.

As the villagers encircled the robbers, they opened fire, leaving Shah Alam, Shahabuddin and Syed Ahmad wounded, police said. The injured were admitted to the Chittagong Medical College Hospital

Omar Faruq, one of the robbers, was caught by the villagers and beaten up severely before police rescued him. He died on way to the hospital
