Acute food crisis due to bad harvest

Diarrhoea and malnutrition due to acute food crisis claimed 17 lives in six villages under Sazek union in Baghaichhori upazila in May.

Of the victims, 10 were in Tuichui and Shialdailui villages, three in Vhuachhori, two in Lonkor, and one each in Batling and Joipui villages, according to Sazek Union Parishad Chairman L Thanga, who is now in the Rangamati town seeking food assistance from the district authori-

He said people in the mountain villages are tribesmen who depend ihum becomes exhausted before

Every year the villagers face acute food crisis during May-June and try to survive on 'wild potato' bamboo roots and other uneatable things collected from forests.

Last year also, the jhum yield was bad, causing malnutrition and diarrhoea, he said.

The UP chairman said, he along with three UP members informed Major Moazzem, BDR commander at Marrissa and Baghaichhori Upazila Nirbahee Officer Musharof Hussain in mid-May about the food
