## BRAC to have ombudsperson

The annual general meeting of BRAC has approved a proposal of BRAC governing body to set up an office of ombudsperson, says a press release.

BRAC believes that any organisation should have total transparency about its policies, programmes and activities by providing opportunities to internal and external individuals and organisations to seek redress of any grievance against it or any of its functionaries.

The office of the ombudsperson will be located outside BRAC premises to ensure its physical independence and also allow privacy to the complainants as well as the ombudsman's and his or her staff in dealing with cases.

The ombudsperson is an independent authority who will receive, investigate and resolve complaints and questions from affected individuals or organisations about unfairness, injustice, rudeness and maltreatment or any other grievance caused by any act or omission on the part of BRAC

which is not ordinarily expected of any organisation.

The ombudsperson's job will be to resolve a complaint in a manner which is fair, just and practical. The term of office will be for a period of four years without any renewal or extension.

The establishments carrying BRAC name but having separate legal status like BRAC University, BRAC Bank and DBH will be outside the ombudsperson's jurisdiction.

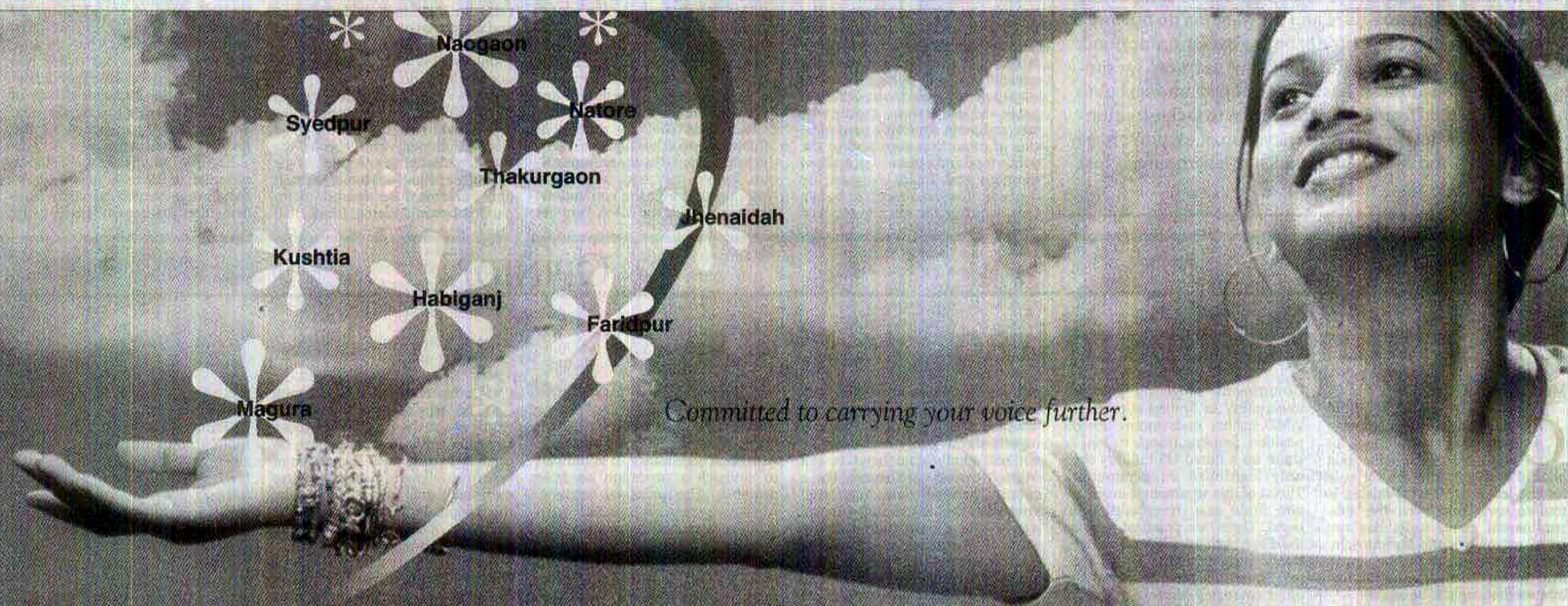
