The ombudsperson is an inde-pendent authority who will receive, investigate and resolve complaints and questions from affected individuals or organisations about unfairness, injustice, rudeness and maltreatment or any other grievance caused by any act or omission on the part of BRAC

which is not ordinarily expected of any organisation. The ombudsperson's job will be to resolve a complaint in a

manner which is fair, just and practical. The term of office will be for a period of four years without any renewal or extension. The establishments carrying BRAC name but having separate

legal status like BRAC University,
