Joynal Hazari gets life in arms case



A court in Feni yesterday handed down life imprisonment to former Awami League (AL) lawmaker and alleged godfather of the crimeprone Feni district Joynal Abedin Hazari and his accomplice Farooq Hossain Mridha in an arms case.

Joint forces during the caretaker government raided the 'Shaila Kutir' of Hazari at Masterpara in the town in his absence on August 17, 2001 and recovered huge arms and ammunition including a rifle, two loaded revolvers, a sub-machine gun magazine. 431 bullets, lethal weapons and contraband items including Viagra.

Feni police filed a case against Joynal Hazari and Farooq in this connection. Hazari is absconding while Farooq is in jail.

Md Feroz Alam, judge of the District and Sessions Judge's Court, Feni, gave the verdict yesterday in a packed courtroom. Security was tightened in and around the court and none was allowed inside the court without being frisked.

The trial of the case started on May 18. Ten out of 14 listed prosecution witnesses deposed during the

Forty criminal cases have been

filed against Hazari since 1970. Twenty-four of them floundered in the absence of the plaintiff or witnesses while 15 are in the process of trial or under investigation.

Hazari reportedly introduced a one man rule' in Feni town and persecuted his political opponents by using a private armed group styled 'Class Committee'. Hazari hogged the headlines after attacking Tipu Sultan, a local journalist and Feni correspondent of UNB news

Hazari's henchmen abducted Tipu on January 25, 2000, beat him in mercilessly with iron rods before

Launch owners called off their wildcat strike yesterday following a discussion with Shipping Minister

Akbar Hossain. During the talks, Akbar urged the owners to refrain from overloading and maintained that the authorities should be strict against the act.

Thieves bore gas lines to pilfer Tk 1 lakh condensate a day

Aided by some policemen and gas pipeline operators, thieves are pilfering liquid gas condensate worth Tk 1 lakh a day by boring holes in gas pipelines.

The Gas Transmission Company Ltd. (GTCL) has found out that up to 10,000 litres of condensate a day are being pilfered by boring holes and installing valves in the pipelines in Ashuganj in Brahmanbaria.

The GTCL sealed one such leakage last week and found a halfsunken boat with 36 drums full of condensate in Brahmanbaria four

remainder by other gas fields of the country. The gas from Sylhet is flowed through Ashuganj station.

Agovernment plant in Kailashtila manufactures liquid petroleum gas (LPG) from condensate for use as cooking fuel. A private firm, Super Refinery, in Chittagong purchases 600 barrels a day for the same purpose. However, there are allegations that a large part is leaked out from the refinery and used as kerosene adulterant.
