


Songs of Tagore Philosophy, Selected Translations, Paint-







Wavell The Viceroy's Journal Edited by Penderel Moon Price: Tk 600.00 When Churchill selected Field Marshal Si

Archibald Wavell, Commander-in-Chief India, to succeed Lord Linlithgow as Viceroy in October 1943, he intended him to act as a stopgap, to keep things guiet until the war ended. But Wavell was not the man for inaction, and Churchill discovered to his chagrin that the Viceroy-designate had liberal ideas.

The main significance of Wavell's vicerovalty lies in two fateful decision: one, that India should be granted independence within eighteen months, and two, that India should be divided. It is, at least, arguable that if Wavell had been given a freer hand or if the British Government followed his advice and acted with the firmness and decisiveness that he advocated, the transfer of power could have been effected without the disasters that actually accompanied it.


