

Stephen Harmison's double strike revived England's hopes of a series squaring win on the fourth day of the fifth and final Test against South Africa at The Oval here Sunday. At tea, the Proteas were 101 for

four in their second innings, still 19 behind after Andrew Flintoff's rapid 95 had propelled England to 604 for nine declared and a first innings lead of 120 earlier Sunday. South Africa, 2-1 up, and looking

for their first series win in England since 1965, were 93 for two when fast bowler Harmison took two wickets in four balls for no runs.

Gritty left-hander Gary Kirsten, who made 190 runs in South Africa's 191 run fourth Test win at Headingley, had made 29 when he edged a rare full length ball from Harmison to first slip Marcus Trescothick.


