Villarreal and Barcelona occupy fifth and sixth places respectively with nine points each from their five games.

Ronaldinho and Kluivert combined well on several more occasions to slice through the Atletico midfield, but they were unable to add the finishing touches to some promising attacks.

It was Atletico, though, who looked to have stolen the lead just before the half hour mark when Mexican defender Rafael Marquez headed into his own net from a corner, but the goal was ruled out for

Atletico sparked in to life for the remainder of the first half, with defender Matias Lequi forcing a fine full-stretch save from Barca keeper Victor Valdes

Barcelona faced an uphill battle after they were reduced to 10 men when Cocu was dismissed on 58 minutes when he picked up a sec-ond booking for a foul on midfielder Kizito Musampa
