## 4 more PWs make deposition

Four more prosecution witnesses (PWs) yesterday made their deposition before the Judge of the Divisional Speedy Trial Tribunal, Chittagong M Hasan Imam in the sensational Laxmipur BNP leader Nurul Islam murder case. Of them, one Abul Kalam Azad, a neighbour of slain leader, was declared 'hostile' by the judge for giving irrelevant accounts and backtracking from what he con-

fessed earlier to police under 164.

#### Intending Hajj pilgrims asked to deposit money by Oct 30

Persons willing to perform Hajj under the government management in 2004 have been asked to deposit money by October 30 with any of 11 banks.

The banks are: Sonali Bank, Bank, Pubali Bank, Islami Bank Bangladesh Limited, Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Al Arafa Islamic Bank Limited, Oriental Bank Limited, City Bank Limited and Rajshahi Krishi Unnayan Bank.

The pilgrims belonging to category "A" will have to deposit Tk 1,27,097 and category "B" Tk 1,10,612, according to an official release.

The pilgrims can deposit the money either in one or three installments. The date for depositing Hajj money will not be extended further, the release said.

### 1259 more arrested
