Arrest of 11 BCP cadres Outlaws threaten to blow up thana, kill OC in Khulna

The Biplobi Communist Party (BCP) has given 'death threat' to Ashraful Islam, officer-in-charge of Phultala thana, for arresting its 'regional leader' Faruque Molla along with ten cadres including a young woman from Tarapur village in Narail sadar upazila in the early hours of

According to the OC, Faruque Molla is an FIR-named accused in 20 criminal cases including four murder cases recorded with Phultala thana alone.
