Twelve people died of diarrhoea and over 250 have been attacked with the disease in Brahmanbaria and Sherpur districts in the last five days.

The disease has spread to four upazilas in Brahmanbaria and 13 villages in one upazila in Sherpur.

Our Brahmanharia correspondent reported that the disease killed five people including two children and attacked 200 in several villages in Nasirnagor, Sarail, Ashugonj and Brahmanbaria Sadar upazilas.

The five died in Chaportola union where at least 50 are afflicted with diarrhoea

Chapartala union Chapartola Union Parishad Chairman Musharof Hassain told the monthly meeting of Nasirnagar Upazila Council on Thursday that the five died due to lack of medicine. Diarrhoea is spreading in the area and will turn alarming if adequate steps are not taken immediately, he said.

When contacted the Medical Officer at Nasirnagor Upazila Health Complex declined to confirm the deaths. He said a medical team has been sent to the
