Assault of army officer Charges to be pressed against 8 JCD cadres soon

Charges will be framed within a couple of days against eight Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal cadres responsible for assaulting an army officer, said a police official yesterday.

The eight cadres were arrested for assaulting Second Lieutenant Zubayer in the city's Barutkhana area on the night of November 7.

All the accused except one have been arrested, the official said. The

main accused Habib Ibne Islam Chamakis yet to be arrested.

JCD cadres Chamak, Muhibul Haque Chowdhury Rahi, Dibya Roy, Hakim, Lavlu and others swooped on the army officer. They pointed fire-arms at the army man and hurled abusive words during an altercation with him.

Station Commander of Jalalabad Cantonment Brigadier General Matiur Rahman filed a case under Speedy Trial

Act with the Kotwali police against them.

Of the accused, five were arrested in Dhaka on November 9. They are Rahi, Humayun Kabir Khan, Lipu Banik, Junel Ahmed and Aminur Rahman Pavel.

The private car in which they were travelling in Dhaka was also recovered.

The five were produced before the Sadar Magistrate's court on November 10.

Meanwhile, the police took three accused -- Dibya, Lavlu and Rahi -- on one-day remand while others were sent to jail hajat.

Dibya, Lavlu and Hakim were arrested from Sylhet within the 24 hours of the incident.

All the members of the group are accused in cases like murder, snatching, extortion and kidnapping, police said.

Meanwhile, Mashuk Ahmed, a former JCD leader, filed a case two days after the incident with the Kotwali police alleging that his car was hijacked by Rahi and others two days ago.

CU building needs renovation

Physical structure of the arts faculty of Chittagong University is now on the verge of collapse due to utter neglect by the authorities concerned over the years.

In an exchange of views, the teachers and students said as many as 5,000 students in nine departments under the faculty have been attending their classes risking their lives.

Big cracks have developed in many parts of the ceilings and walls of the buildings, pointing to an imminent danger, they added.

Guardians were also present at the

meeting.

Sources at engineering office quoted the guardians as saying that the structural design of the building is not suitable for a country like Bangladesh which experiences heavy rainfall every year.

The window panes of most rooms of the building are broken, with hooks of many doors are not functional. Teachers have to take classes keeping the doors open. This causes disturbances for the students.

During the rainy season, sufferings of the students of arts faculty know no bounds as water leaks through the roof and drench their classrooms.
