Bangladesh Samajtantrik Dal (JSD-Inu) yesterday formed a human chain in the city protesting the Banskhal incident in which 11 members of a minority family were burnt to death.

Addressing a rally after the human chain at Muktagong, JSD President Hasanul Haque Inu said social security of religious minority proves how democratic a country is.

He said attack on the Ahmedia mosque in the city was the result of communal politics pursued by the ruling coalition government.

Inu urged all to build resistance against the communal forces for the sake of democracy.

He said the criminals have become desperate due to intimate relationship with the ruling party stalwarts.

Presided over by JSD city unit President Mir Hossain Akhter, the rally was also addressed by JSD General Secretary Syed Zafar Sajjad, Joint

Secretary Shirin Akhter, Organising Secretary Mohammed Khaled and Advocate Habibur Rahman Shawkat.

Mobile courts realise Tk 2 lakh as fine
