Customs officials at Zia International Airport (ZIA) yesterday recovered gold ornaments weighing five and half kilograms and 158 mobile phone sets worth about Tk 75 lakh.

The gold and phone sets were found in an abandoned suitcase brought in Dhaka by a Biman flight from Dubai that landed at 10:00am. The name of one Shamsuddin, a

Chittagong-bound passenger, was on the sticker tagged with the suit-But after consulting Biman, the

officials learnt that Shamsuddin was not among the passengers in the flight.

The items include 256 pieces of churi, 51 rings, 37 chains, 15 brace-lets, 14 pairs of earrings and 158 Samsung mobile phone sets.


