PRIMERA LIGA **Clemente too racist!**

Barcelona opened up a sevenpoint gap at the top of the Spanish first division with a 2-1 win over relegation-threatened Athletic Bilbao on Sunday.

However, the game was overshadowed by the post-match comments of Athletic coach Javier Clemente who referred to Samuel Eto'o as having, "descended from trees.

Clemente was incensed that Eto'o, the Spanish first division's top scorer and the reigning African Player of the Year, had spat at one of his players towards the end of the game, but his words were viewed as a racist slur.

Goals from Ronaldinho and Lionel Messi responded to the early shock of going behind after 16 minutes from a header by Athletic's Fernando Llorente and extended Barca's winning streak to 12 league games.

The Catalan club's impressive lead over the rest of their rivals at the end of the first half of the Spanish season was helped by second-placed Osasuna losing 2-0 at Valencia on Saturday.

Athletic came out fighting at the Nou Camp and silenced the Barca faithful when Llorente was left unmarked to head home a Francisco Yeste cross from wide on the right flank.

A huge upset started to look on the cards with Barca looking second best for much of the first half until Ronaldinho levelled from the penalty spot seven minutes before the break.

The two-time World Player of the Year got his 12th goal of the season after Athletic defender Fernando Amorebieta was judged to have handled the ball.

Messi then hammered home the winner six minutes after half time from just inside the six-yard

Nevertheless, it was an unimpressive performance from Barca, and the night ended on a negative

note when Deco was sent off for pulling Carlos Gurpegui's hair after a clumsy challenge from the Athletic midfielder.
