Rafter, Sabatini in Tennis Hall of Fame

Two-time US Open champion Patrick Rafter and Gabriela Sabatini, the first female player from Argentina to win a Grand Slam singles title, have been elected to the International Tennis Hall of Fame.

The 33-year-old Rafter, twice a runner-up at Wimbledon in his 12year career, is the 24th Australian to

This is one of the highs. I don't think there is any more, this is it for me," Rafter said Monday at the official announcement during the Australian Open, "I'm really surprised to receive this so younge I expected it to come later on, when I was older."Rafter won 11 singles titles, including the 1997 and 1998 US Opens, and reached a careerhigh No. 1 in July 1999. He also won 12 doubles titles, including the 1999 Australian Open, and was an eight-year member of Australia's Davis Cun team.

Sabatini won the 1990 US Open, reached No. 3 in the world and was ranked in the top 10 for 10 straight years. The 35-year-old player won 27 WTA Tour singles titles and 14 doubles titles, including the 1988 Wimbledon crown with Steffi Graf.

"The majority of my life has revolved around my tennis, so it is a very special honour to be elected ... especially when you look at all the great names of champions that have been elected over the years," Sabatini said in a statement.

Italian sports writer Gianni Clerici also will be inducted July 15 in Newport, Rhode Islands.

Ferdinand's goal was his third in eight games, a statistic made all the more remarkable by the fact he did not score in his first 140 United

European champions Liverpool remained third, 18 points adrift of the leaders and four behind United but with two games in hand on the only two sides above them in the

"To win so late on is a great feeling," United manager Sir Alex

"Liverpool are a very difficult side to play against and they are a very powerful side but we felt we had enough quality to keep at them and in the last 20 minutes we probably deserved to win because of

The victory will have been just the tonic Ferguson, who rates this match as the fixture in English football, wanted.

And his joy was likely to have been increased by the presence of Sven-Goran Eriksson in the Old Trafford crowd after the England coach reportedly told a British newspaper Sunday that Ferguson should have quit following United's treble-winning season in 1999.

It was Ryan Giggs, the original Fergie Fledgling', who was at the heart of much of United's best work. Giggs produced a rare moment of United quality in the first-half when he released Ruud van Nistelrooy although the Dutchman's shot was comfortably

It was a tale of two strikers at the African Nations Cup on Sunday one who covered himself in glory and the other in shame.

Brazilian-born marksman Santos scored a hat-trick as champions Tunisia opened the defence of their title and their bid to become only the second side to retain the trophy since it became a 16 team event with a 4-1 victory over a plucky Zambian side in Group C

It took the Toulouse striker's tally to seven in the African showpiece having scored five in 2004 and within seven of the overall record of 14 held by Ivory Coast's Laurent Pokou.

While he revelled in deserved glory Emmanuel Adebayor saw his status as Togolese national hero stripped away after he was labelled earns far less than Adebayor playa 'cry baby' by national coach Stephen Keshi.

The 21-year-old, whose 11 goals inspired the country to their first ever World Cup finals this year, refused to play in Saturday's opening 2-0 defeat to the Democratic Republic of Congo, though he came on for part of the second period.


