AIUB's Excellence in Leadership

Any university is a self-righteous stronghold of highest education. As such it is taken for granted that the environment in and around the university is ideal for those who come to learn and those who impart learning. AIUB, ever since its inception, has been committed to maintain and enhance this principle.

Advancement

Founded in 1995 with 71 students, AIUB now has 3910 students pursuing undergraduate and graduate degrees in various disciplines. In today's 6th convocation, 597 students are graduating, the largest ever in the history of private universities in Bangladesh.

Research and Publications

In the research arena, AIUB has boldly continued with its two academic journals:

- AIUB Journal of Science and Technology (AJSE) and
- AIUB Journal of Business and Economics (AJBE).

 Several issues of both the journals have been published and the journals have been appreciated by the academics of the country and abroad. To make its unique mark in the research arena, the AIUB Center for Research and Excellence (ACRE) was recently established to strengthen the research culture of the university and promote excellence in its academic programs.

Infrastructure

AIUB has consistently invested largely in its infrastructure facilities. The faculty of Engineering has moved to a new building with 16 state-of-the-art engineering labs equipped with instruments from Europe, Canada and USA. The labs are the Analogue Electronics Lab, Circuit Lab, Computer Networking & Computer System Architecture Lab, Control System Lab, Digital Electronics Lab, DSP Lab, Machine Lab, Measurement & Instrumental Lab, Microcomputer Lab, Microprocessor Lab, Microwave Engineering Lab, Motor Trans & Winding Repair Shop, PCB Etching Room, Power Electronics Lab, Telecommunications Lab and VLSI Lab.

The IT department is equipped with all the latest hardware and software facilities having 12 powerful servers, 400 workstations in 6 state-of-the-art computer labs. The network backbone uses a fiber optic cable for optimum bandwidth of 100 MBPS. The latest addition to AIUB's IT infrastructure is the VSAT which has made information sharing and data management tremendously fast-paced.

Outside the academic arena, AIUB thrives for brilliance in numerous co-curricular activities. Some of the activities undertaken in the previous years are the AIUB Inter-University Programming Contest, Inter-School &

Inter-University Debate Competition, Business Plan competition, AIUB Cup Cricket, Study Tours to India and Singapore.

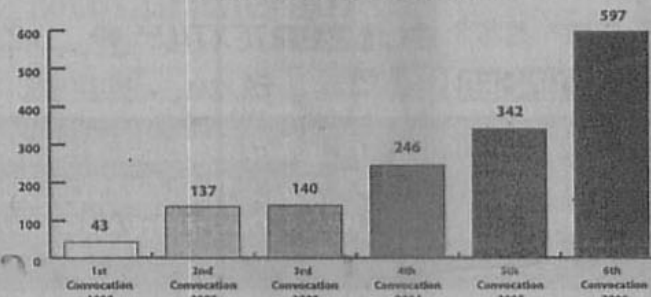
Distinction in Leadership

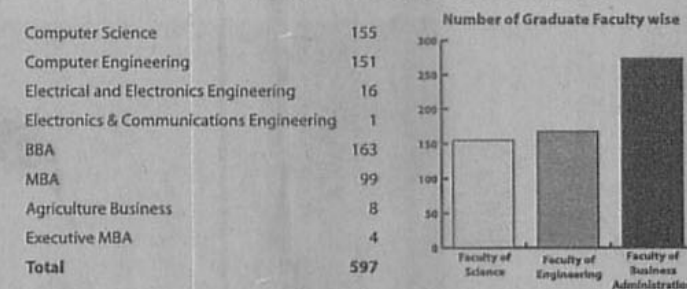
