Veteran actor Nadira passed away in Mumbai last Thursday after a prolonged illness. She was 73. Nadira was admitted to Bhatia hospital on January 2 after a paralytic stroke. She was also suffering from other complications

and had been in coma, doctors said Way ahead of her time, Nadira led the way for character artistes in Bollywood. Not many know that her original name is Florence Ezekeil. Nadira was one of the most

flambovant heroines in the 1950s and 1960s At a time when most heroines portrayed the stereotypi-cal 'goody two shoes', Nadira was way ahead of her times

playing vamps and negative roles This actor from Israel took Hindi cine-goers by storm with her debut movie Aan opposite Dilip Kumar in 1952. This was followed by Waris and Dak Babu in 1954. Nadira also had films like Shree 420, Bombay Talkies, Pakeezah,

However, she had shunned the limelight for the last few years. She was last seen in the film Josh in 2000. She had also played a role in Mahesh Bhatt's Tamanna and a teleseries, Margaritta.

A star who faded away, this golden girl of Hindi cinema however spent the last phase of her life all alone in a

A woman so ahead of her time, Nadira was indeed a woman for all time. One of her fellow actors rightly said, "What today's woman strives to be, Nadira was just that 50 years ago.


