

WC WARM-UP AT BAKU

Ukraine sans Shevchenko

Ukraine are without their top player Andriy Shevchenko for the World Cup warm-up against Azerbaijan in Baku on Tuesday.

The AC Milan striker was allowed to miss the match which coach Oleg Blokhin hopes will help him with decisions concerning his squad for the World Cup in Germany.

"I am just testing the players. I want to see them in a friendly match as we have not had everyone together for some time," Blokhin said in an interview on Dynamo Kiev's official website.

Ukraine meet Spain, Tunisia and Saudi Arabia in Group H at the World Cup which starts on June.

Local media said Blokhin believed Shevchenko's abilities were beyond question and he was not strictly required in Baku. Shevchenko was due to take part in a publicity event in Kiev organised by a mobile phone company sponsoring the team.

Ukraine are also without two key players, goalkeeper Oleksander Shovkovsky and midfielder Anatoly Tymoshchuk, who are both injured.

Players Blokhin will be taking particular notice of are goalkeeper Bogdan Shust of Shakhtar Donetsk, midfielders Sergei Serebrynnikov of Charleroi and Maxim Kalinichenko of Spartak Moscow and defender Oleksander Kucher of Kharkiv Metallist, Ukrainian media said.

Blokhin was concerned, however, that the poor state of the Baku pitch might hinder his players.

"This is no pitch," he said. "It's nothing more than a vegetable patch."

Perez departure saddens Becks

Real Madrid president Florentino Perez's surprise resignation was said England captain David Beckham on Tuesday.

Beckham, who was speaking ahead of England's friendly with Uruguay, did pledge his future to 'the meringues' but paid homage to Perez, who was responsible for bringing players like himself Zinedine Zidane, Luis Figo and Ronaldo to the club.

"No not at all," Beckham said in response to a question about if it would affect his future at Madrid.

"It was a surprise, I only heard late last night.

"I would like to thank Florentino for having given me the chance to play for such a great club.

"He's very intelligent. I have only good memories. He has to be congratulated on bringing such great players to the club.

"Obviously I don't know what is going to happen. However the club has already said they want me to stay. I am happy there and would like to stay there," added Beckham, who has had an up and down career with Madrid since he left Manchester United.

Perez resigned after an extraordinary meeting of the board on Monday which confirmed Perez would go and that Fernando Martin, a club vice-president, would take over the hot seat.

"The World Cup is not an important objective, it's the greatest objective. We'll go to Germany to win the World Cup."

Perez parts with Real

Florentino Perez resigned as Real Madrid president on Monday, a day after his side lost 2-1 to struggling Real Mallorca and with his club facing the prospect of a third successive season without a major trophy.

"I decided to call an urgent board meeting today because I believe that the club needs a change of direction and as a result I have decided to resign as president of Real Madrid.

"Something has been going wrong and everyone could see that in yesterday's match against Mallorca. That's when I made up my mind to leave.

"I hope this decision will help us change direction and I believe that we still have a chance of achieving something in the European Cup this season. At the very least I hope it will enable us to plan properly for next season."

The 58-year-old construction magnate said that director Fernando Martin, a leading property speculator, had been the unanimous choice of the board to take over in his place.

Perez was elected president by club members in 2000 and returned once again in a landslide victory in July 2004.

He was responsible for ridding the club of its massive 270 million euros (\$319.8 million) of debt by selling its city-centre training ground for a reported 480 million euros soon after he came to power.

However he will be best remembered for his "Galacticos" policy which brought in a string of world-

class players, such as Luis Figo, Zinedine Zidane, Ronaldo and David Beckham and helped make Real the most glamorous football club in the world.

The policy also acted as the springboard which allowed Real to become a global leader in the marketing stakes and overtake Manchester United as the richest football club in the world.

On the sporting side Perez met with early success, with the club winning the Champions League in

2002 and the league title in 2001 and 2003.

But the team's fortunes suffered a decisive downturn after Perez decided to discard Vicente del Bosque as coach the day after they won the league title and shortly after England captain David Beckham was signed.

Real have got through five coaches since then, but have not managed to win any major silverware.

If they fail to win anything this season it will be the first time in 52 years that they have gone three

consecutive seasons without winning a significant trophy.

Real were knocked out of the King's Cup by Real Zaragoza earlier this month after suffering a humiliating 6-1 defeat in the first leg and have an uphill task to make the quarter-finals of the Champions League after losing 1-0 at home to Arsenal.

Sunday's league defeat at Mallorca left them 10 points behind arch-rivals Barcelona with 13 games left to play.

Perez made it clear that his decision to quit was not only down to poor results, but also due to the attitude of the players and the rifts that were emerging in the squad.

"I think we have played some spectacular football in these years, but maybe some of the players may have begun to get confused and I may have contributed to that confusion.

"The club needs a profound renewal and I think that someone else will be a more appropriate figure to oversee that process."

Perez said he was in agreement with defender Sergio Ramos's comments about the lack of team spirit at the club after the 19-year-old complained about his team mates' lukewarm celebration when he scored the opening goal against Mallorca.

"Sergio Ramos was right in what he said and I would like to see our players celebrate goals in the same way that Mallorca celebrated their goals," said Perez.

Ramos's remarks came less than a week after Real Madrid captain Raul publicly reprimanded Brazilian striker Ronaldo for his criticisms of the club's fans on the eve of their Champions League match against Arsenal.

Ruud wants his place back

Ruud van Nistelrooy has demanded a recall to the Manchester United starting lineup but attempted to play down reports of a bust-up with Sir Alex Ferguson.

The Dutch striker looked miserable after being left out of United's 4-0 League Cup final win over Wigan on Sunday and reports have claimed his relationship with Ferguson is at breaking point.

Van Nistelrooy however has insisted that he accepted the rationale behind the manager's decision to pick Louis Saha for the final given the French striker's five goals earlier in the competition.

"The manager told me before the game that I wasn't playing," said van Nistelrooy, who is on international duty with The Netherlands this week.

"I was very disappointed but I could understand why he wanted to play Louis because he has been playing very well in the competition this season."

Italy, Germany's pre-test

European superpowers Italy and Germany square up here Wednesday in an eagerly-anticipated friendly that will help gauge their World Cup credentials.

Both countries are among the favourites in Germany this summer given their rich international pedigree, with three World Cup wins apiece and four European championship triumphs between them.

Italy coach Marcello Lippi is relishing the opportunity to pit his wits against the tournament hosts.

"They are a great team with a wonderful history, and as hosts of the World Cup they are very ambitious," he said.

"For us it's one of the last real tests before we fly out to Germany, one that we hope will build our confidence."

Lippi said he hoped the Italy fans would get behind his team at the Artemio Franchi stadium, home of Serie A side Fiorentina.

"We are playing in Florence where the people are passionate about football and a lot will depend on their support."

Germany coach Jurgen Klinsmann is playing down his side's chances of victory against the Azzurri.

"Italy have quality in every position, and Lippi's squad is more mature and more experienced than ours," said the 41-year-old, who took control of Germany in July 2004.

"They have a team full of champions while we are a young side looking for its identity, one that plays aggressive, attacking football."

Klinsmann expressed his sadness over the injury to Italy's talismanic number 10 Francesco Totti, whose chances of featuring in Germany are hanging in the balance after he broke a bone in his left leg.

"I'm sad to see him injured, he's an exceptional player," he said.

"However, Alessandro Del Piero can replace him or Lippi can change his system. He has players who can adapt."

The last time Germany saw off one of the game's so-called football heavyweights was back in October 2000, when they beat England 1-0 in a 2002 World Cup qualifier and

Klinsmann is desperate to put that right.

"We want to put an end to our negative run against big name opposition," he said.

Klinsmann knows what it takes to unlock an Italian defence having played for Inter Milan from 1989 to 1992.

He scored 36 goals in 103 years appearances and helped Inter win the UEFA Cup in 1991.

Germany's first-choice goalkeeper Oliver Kahn has been ruled out due to a thigh strain, so Arsenal's Jens Lehmann will deputise. Stuttgart keeper Timo Hildebrand will act as Lehmann's understudy.

With Italy's left-sided defender Gianluca Zambrotta unavailable, Fiorentina defender Manuel Pasqual could make his first appearance for the Azzurri in front of his home crowd.

Wednesday's match revives memories of the classic 1982 World Cup final in Spain which Italy won 3-1.

The most memorable image of the tournament was Marco Tardelli's wild celebrations -- wild eyes and pumping fists -- after scoring Italy's second goal.

Ballack denies Chelsea deal

Germany captain Michael Ballack refuted a British newspaper report on Tuesday that he has signed a four-year deal worth 25 million pounds (43 million dollars) to join Chelsea next season.

The Bayern Munich midfielder, in Florence for Germany's World Cup warm-up against Italy on Wednesday, issued a statement through German FA spokesman Harald Stenger saying: "I have not signed anything and I was also not in London."

Earlier on Tuesday Ballack's agent Michael Becker had also denied the claim that the player had signed a deal that would make him the world's highest-paid player.

Britain's Daily Mail reported that Ballack, who is out of contract after four years with Bayern Munich at the end of the season, had agreed to move to the big-spending London club on a weekly wage of 121,000 pounds (210,500 dollars).

"This is all starting to get boring and tiring," Becker told Germany's Spiegel Online: "I can only say that

Michael has not signed anywhere."

In Munich, Bayern officials declined to comment.

Chelsea's policy is not to discuss any potential transfers until a contract is signed.

The Daily Mail said that Ballack, who joined Bayern after helping Bayer Leverkusen reach the 2002

Champions League final against Real Madrid, met Chelsea officials, including manager Jose Mourinho, twice last month in London.

Although Mourinho generally steers away from signing superstar

players, the lure of Ballack, one of the most complete midfielders in the game, could persuade him to bend that policy.

Earlier this season Ballack had an offer from Bayern for a four-year contract worth a reported total of 36 million euros (43 million dollars). It would have been the most lucrative deal in Bundesliga history.

The club withdrew the offer in November after Ballack failed to meet their deadline.

Bayern still want to persuade the 29-year-old to sign a new deal but have said on different terms to the previous offer they tore up in anger over his failure to make up his mind.

They are aware they will receive nothing for him if he moves on a Bosman free transfer once his contract expires in July.

Ballack, Germany's Player of the Year in 2005, has long hinted he would like to spend the next segment of his career abroad with a team capable of winning the Champions League.

Clubs who have reportedly been in the running for his services have included Real Madrid, Barcelona, Manchester United, AC Milan, Inter Milan and Juventus.
