- To update WHO Representative, Bangladesh on the news covered by the national and international news media- this could be done by maintaining in-house news clipping service/web news service, including to Regional office. The media consultant must particularly alert the WR to any outbreak news or any stories that could prove controversial or detrimental to WHO's interests.
- To support the WR in addressing 'difficult' or controversial questions on such issues that the media might raise.
- To act as Media Consultant on the approved communications by WHO Representative, Bangladesh on the WHO role in the national and international health programmes inclusive of the development partners;
- To integrate health programme related information from the local, national and international sources and disseminate information with prior approval from the WHO Representative to Bangladesh;
- To undertake the responsibility for editing and publishing the WHO News Letter and act as a Member of the WHO Web Site Committee;
- Represent WHO in the seminars, workshops or policy formulation meetings organized by Government of Bangladesh, UN Agencies and Development Partners as and when assigned by WHO Representative to Bangladesh.
- To support WHO Regional Office (RO) and HQ media initiatives which require country inputs. This would include providing media support to key Governing council meetings and major Regional meetings (RC, HMM, CCPDM,) and other key inter country and international meetings.
