

Six national cricketers including captain Habibul Bashar has signed a deal with a local agent on Tuesday to take care of their personal endorsements till next year's World Cup.

Vice-captain and wicketkeeper Khaled Mashud, left-arm spinner Mohammad Rafique, Mohammad Ashraful, Javed Omar and Shahriar Nafees Ahmed were the other cricketers signed the agreement with SBSL (Sky Business Services Limited) in a function at local hote yesterday.

It was the first time in the country the players came under an agency, which will bargain for their personal sponsorship deals
