### **Germany warns** hooligans

Germany said on Thursday it was ready to tighten border controls during this year's soccer World Cup and pledged to make life hard for potential troublemakers.

Interior Minister Wolfgang Schaeuble said Berlin would temporarily suspend the European Union's Schengen travel agreement to allow it to make border checks.

Travellers in the Schengen zone of 15 European countries can normally move freely across borders without showing an identity card, but member states can suspend the accord and reintroduce controls at times of heightened security alert.

Terrorism and hooliganism are the chief concerns of German officials as they prepare to host the month-long World Cup, one of the biggest events in sport.

More than a million foreign fans will attend the 64 matches and an unknown number will travel to Germany even though they have no tickets for the games.

FIFA president Sepp Blatter revealed Wednesday that he intends to run for re-election in 2007, providing he is still in good health

The 70-year-old Blatter took over the FIFA presidency from Brazilian Joao Havelange in 1998 and feels he can carry on until 2011

"Yes I will make myself available again in 2007." Blatter said. "The only question is how my health will be then.

AC Milan striker Andriv Shevchenko has rejected newspaper reports that he has agreed a move to English club Chelsea

The Guardian reported on Thursday that Shevchenko had agreed "in principle to a four-year contract worth in excess of 110,000 pounds (191,700 dollars) a week' and that the player had told Chelsea he would put in a transfer request to

But the Ukrainian striker told the talian news agency ANSA: "I don't know of any offer and I am calm. don't need to deny anything, it is all clear. It is just that others keep talking about this story," he said.

Shevchenko, who is in his seventh season with Milan after joining them from Dynamo Kiev, recently said that he hoped to emulate captain Paolo Maldini and stay with the club until the end of his career.

The striker has frequently been linked with a move to Chelsea who are owned by Russian billionaire Roman Abramovich, but he laughed off the latest reports saying: "I'd like to thank the English journalists because this way maybe Milan will call me and extend my contract".

This season Shevchenko has scored 19 goals in 24 Serie A matches and eight in nine Champions League appearances.

The two teams are scheduled to play two Tests and three one-day internationals, starting with the first Test in Dhaka on April 9.
