Housewife beaten to death for dowry

A housewife was beaten to death allegedly for dowry in the city on Tuesday night.

The victim was identified as Khorsheda, 28, wife of Md Ali who lives in Khilkhet area.

Khorsheda was beaten mercilessly by her husband who hit her in the abdomen causing profuse bleeding. She died on the spot, said Abdus Salam, victim's brother while

He said Ali had been demanding dowry since Khorsheda's marriage 10 years back.

"About three months back, Ali again demanded Tk 1 lakh which we refused to pay," Salam said, adding
