Aaina: Women's issues take

centre stage

CCLAIMED actress Kabori Sarwar has emerged as a screen playwright and director through the film Aaina. The film features the oppression of women in a male-dominated soci-

Kushum (Sabah), like many poor girls in rural Bangladesh, is a victim of dowry, lechery and other social ills. A village terrorist (Joy Raj) kills her father to marry her. To escape from the clutches of the evildoer, Kushum comes to Dhaka and gets a job as a domestic help. However, here also she attracts the attention of a lascivious landlord. The latter's wife, rather than vent her spleen on her husband, orders Kushum to leave the house. The film Aaina clearly delineates the miserable condition of housewives in the metros, who time after time have to compromise with their husband's misdeeds.

The craftsmanship of Kabori Sarwar's screenplay deserves plaudits. The film features the lifestyle of slum-dwellers and garment workers. It gives an authentic portraval of the oppression on women workers, who are the backbone of the industry. At the end of the movie Kushum becomes

However, Kabori's screenplay is a trifle abrupt at the beginning of the movie while featuring the plight of rural women. As debutant director, Kabori deserves plaudits. The story is minus vulgarity, rather it is artistically handled. And a momentum has been maintained throughout the movie. Framing and cinematography are also better than the average

Shama Rahman Looking back at Tagore

For Tagore singer Shama Rahman, it's not just Tagore's birth anniversary that matters; every day is a celebration of the great bard's life and work. However, she does have plans for May 8--rendering Tagore songs on the various TV channels.

Explaining what Rabindra Sangeet means to her, she says eloquently, "Tagore songs enrich me greatly. When I am happy, sad or in trouble, I take shelter in Rabindranath. And I like to share the experience with people."

In addition to her singing, Shama is busy shooting for TARA Muzik's weekly programme, titled, Gitobitan. This programme is dedicated to Rabindra Sangeet and features the poet's songs, discussions about his philosophy and his effect on listeners. In addition, her singing has taken her for performances in Mumbai, Kolkata, while she was centre stage recently in a solo performance at the Alliance Francaise, Dhaka.

"The response I get from my audience, is my greatest reward, says Shama. She recounts an anecdote from one of her memorable performances. Memory takes her back four years to a programme organised in Dhanmondi by her late friend Nasreen Haque, the wellknown social activist. The gathering mainly comprised of women with breast cancer and friends of patients who had lost their lives to this deadly disease. "I was asked to sing the favourite songs of the audience. It felt really good to see the happiness writ large on their

faces," says Shama. For Shama, nature is a perennial source of inspiration. Shama has trod a long road with Rabindra Sangeet. She began training in this genre from an early

age. Her initial training was at home under the supervision of late Ustad Fazlul Hug with classical music. Later, she studied music at Chhayanat for two years. Finally she was a student at the Bulbul Academy of Fine Arts (BAFA) under late AtiquI Islam for five years.

Shama is now looking at new directions. She says that her interest lies in teaching, where she believes she could "contribute to society and also promote Tagore's music." Meanwhile as an avid Rabindra Sangeet lover, she strives to imbibe his philosophy and songs in her day to day life

Mukunda Das. Based on Das, the troupe put up its new production titled Loko Nayak. Seasoned theatre activist Nikhil Sen conducted the workshops and presented a keynote paper at the seminar. The main event of the three-day

celebration was held on May 6 at Mahila Samity Stage. On the day, renowned cultural activists of the country such as Asad Chowdhury, Asaduzzaman Noor, MP and others

carried out a discussion on the seminar paper read by Nikhil Sen.

The title of the seminar was 'Social commitment of artist: Bard Mukunda Das and Artistes of the day'. Renowned poet-playwright-novelist Syed Shamsul Hag was the chief guest while acclaimed jatra artiste Jyotsna Biswas was the special guest of the programme. Mukunda Das (1878-1934) began

writing nationalist songs and folk plays based on the anti-British swadeshi movement. In his songs, Das called for the boycott of foreign goods and described the oppression by the British in simple, vivid language. Enraged by his songs such as Chhilo dhan gola bhora/ shet indure karlo sara (Granaries filled with rice/ destroyed by white mice), Bhoy ki morone rakhite shontane/ matong metechhe aaj shomor rong, the British government arrested him. However, Das remained undaunted. During the non-cooperation movement in 1922 and the Civil Disobedience Movement in 1930, he continued to inspire people with his songs and plays.

Discussants in the programme urged contemporary artistes to display similar social commitment.
