

For a billion years, ever since egg- and sperm-producing organisms first arose, the genetic futures of males have been affected by what females do, and vice versa. But the selflessness of mothers giving of themselves to offspring has always seemed too vital to the

well-being of too many for anyone-scientists included-to be able to examine their behaviour dispassionately. The specific questions the book addresses are: What do we mean by 'maternal instincts"? And have women "lost" them? If women instinctively love their babies, why have so many women across cultures and through history directly or indirectly contributed to their deaths? Why do so many mothers around the world discriminate among their own infants-for example, feeding a son but starving a daughter? Given that fathers share the same proportion of their genes with babies as mothers do, why didn't fathers evolve to be more attentive to infant needs?
