The Government of Bangladesh established the Japanese Grant Aid for Human Resource Development Scholarship (JDS) with the assistance of the Government of Japan in 2001.

The objective of the JDS is to provide opportunities with Bangladeshi citizens to study in Japan at Master's level by targeting mainly **Government Officials in BCS Cadre** in order to support national efforts. JDS fellows are expected to acquire expert knowledge and build research and human networks in Japan to use such knowledge and take an active role practically in solving the problems that Bangladesh is facing with respect to socio-economic development.

Twenty (20) scholarships will be offered to study in Japan at Master's level for commencement in 2007-2008.
