Lightning kills one in Narsingdi

A boatman was killed and another injured by lightning at village Kacharikandi in Raipur upazila of Narsingdi on Monday. The deceased was identified as Abul Mia, 20.

Injured Usman Mia, 50, was admitted to a clinic of Nabinagar upazila in Brahmanbaria in a critical condition.

Local sources said the thunderbolt struck Abul and Usman when they were taking bath in a canal in neighbouring Narsingdi district at about 1:30pm.
