A fisherman was reported missing as the fishing boat capsized in the Gazaria River early hours of yesterday.

Chandu Bepari, 35, is feared drowned. His two associates --Khorshed Bepari and Yusuf Bepari -have been rescued by the fellow fishermen, police said.

The boat capsized when a tripledecker launch SURAVI-7 dashed the small vessel at about 1:00am near Dahir Char of Mehendiganj upazila.
