The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a grant from the International Development Association (IDA), for co-financing the cost of "Support for Development of Public Sector use of ICT" sub-project under the Economic Management Technical Assistance Project (EMTAP). The government intends to apply part of the grant proceeds to make eligible payments under a contract for consulting services to provide technical assistance o design the physical networks, develop equipment specifications and investment support documents for it establishment of an integrated government wide electronic communications network within the core group of government agencies to improve use of ICT through e-mail, websites, internet portals, integrated records and

The Ministry of Science and Information and Communication Technology (MOSICT), the government agency responsible for ICT related issues has been making efforts to accomplish the goals set out not for establishing e-Governance in the National ICT policy of 2002. This as a result, would enable the government to utilise ICT systems and applications to improve the efficiency, transparency and quality of public services and processes. MOSICT and Bangladesh Computer Council (BCC) prioritised a number of activities in the e-Governance sphere to be implemented by the government to accelerate the use of ICT. Through this component the project will address issues of poor Information flows and access within government and the inadequate and inefficient use of ICT in government.

The Bangladesh Computer Council being the implementing agency now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Their EOIs would be reviewed on the basis of registration of firm, age of firm, availability of key professionals with appropriate skills, availability of resources, experience in similar and other tasks, support services of the firm etc. They must provide relevant brochures, information and documents. Use of ICT within the government is still limited as only a small number of civil servants have internet access and the know-how. Furthermore, strategic ICT planning skills are in short supply within the government. As a result, it is difficult to utilise ICT systems and applications to improve the efficiency, transparency and quality of public services and processes. To meet the vision and objectives of the ICT policy, it is necessary to develop skilled manpower in public sector by training government officials in ICT. This sub-

component will provide technical assistance to develop and implement a capacity building program to assist civil

servants to become ICT literate. Key activities to be undertaken are as follows:

Phase I:

Review the current training programs offered to civil servants, assess their suitability, and identify gaps in the

Develop ICT training curricula for employees in order to ensure that they become computer literate and are able to utilise computers for conducting their tasks.

Develop criteria for the selection of officers who will undergo the training to be provided.
