Opposition goes all out against Hasan takeover


Hasina asks all to enforce blockade Wednesday, hartal Thursday to realise electoral reforms

POWER OUTAGE RU students block road,

vandalise

Several hundred residential students of different dormitories of Rajshahi University (RU) in a frenzy of outrage over power outages blocked traffic on the Dhaka-Rajshahi highway for two hours and vandalised several campus facilities at midnight Sunday including the residence of the vice chancellor (VC) of the university.

Agrani Bank RU branch, the second administrative building and the power regulatory office were other on-campus targets of the students' wrath.

At around 11:00pm on Sunday, the students built fires with tyres

power crisis

The acute power crisis continues to plague the country with no sign of an immediate respite from load shedding that hovered around 2,200 megawatts yesterday.

According to official count, it was however not more than 1,100MW

Power Development Board (PDB) sources said that a couple of power units might resume operation within the next week.

Currently, as many as 19 units remain shut down either for technical glitches or for maintenance reasons, slashing the electricity-

generating capacity by 867 MW. The 450-MW unit of SEE PAGE 15 COL 3 : Meghnaghat AES, which has been

closed for overhauling, will start functioning later this month.

The 250-MW Barapukuria plant is another major installation that ceased working three days ago due to technical problems. The PDB is not sure when this plant will start working again. The costly coal-fired plant has been tripping fre-quently since it came into opera-

tion earlier this year.
Like the last several days, Dhaka and other parts of the country were experiencing frequent power outages that in some places lasted for about eight hours. Over the last couple of days, the city dwellers have been seeing the worst outages in recent times.

Top 4 defaulters hold 31pc of total bad loans

10 top banks burdened with Tk 9,031cr classified loans

Bangladesh Petroleum Corporation (BPC), Bangladesh Textile Mills Corporation (BTMC), Autorickshaw Samabay Samity (ASS) and Khulna Newsprint Mills (KNM) are the four top loan defaulters in 10 leading banks of

These four entities using government guarantee to obtain the loans are holding 31 per cent of the

total defaulted loans of Tk 9,031 crore as of March this year, according to Bangladesh Bank (BB) data.

Twenty top defaulters, including these four, are responsible for 49 per cent of the total defaulted loans with these banks. BB's Deputy Governor

Mohammad A Rumi Ali at a meeting with these 10 banks asked them to engage special teams for each of the defaulters to speed up recovery of the loans

Ali noted that many borrowers have simultaneously defaulted on loans with different banks. For instance, Gaffar Food Production Ltd is at once a simultaneous defaulter with the City Bank, Premier, IFIC and Islami banks. He asked the banks to identify such borrowers and notify the central
