Request for Expressions of Interest for Technical Assistance in Design, Supervision, Training & NGO Coordination, Monitoring & Evaluation to MIDPCR

This request for expressions of interest follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in UN Development Business issue number 686 of 16 September 2006 and to be published in UN Development Business, Ref. No. 621-687.

The government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and a grant from the government of the Netherlands towards the cost of the proposed "Market Infrastructure Development Project in Charland Regions (MIDPCR)" and it intends to apply a part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the contract for Technical Assistance in Design, Supervision, Training & NGO Coordination, Monitoring & Evaluation to MIDPCR.

The goal of the project is to improve the well-being and to reduce the poverty of primary producers, char-based women and men traders, landless and single women and their households through: (i) improvement of the market facilities in terms of access to markets and improvement of market management; (ii) generation of wage employment opportunities for poor women; (iii) increased production and sale of marketable crops and other products, and (iv) improved marketing linkages and movement of primary producers up the value chain. The project will develop physical infrastructure for markets and farm-to-market roads, alongside building the capacity for market management employing women labour contracting societies. The project will support market traders, other small business and primary producers in terms of technical and management training and access to credit. The project will contract NGOs to perform group formation, income generating activities training and to provide micro financing to the members.

The project will be implemented by Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) in estuarine chars of 20 upazilas in five districts of Bangladesh during the period from February 2006-Jun 2013. The selected upazilas are: 7 upazilas in Bhola districts: Sadar, Borhanuddin, Charfasson, Daulat Khan, Lalmoan, Monpura, Tazumuddin; 4 upazilas in Noakhali districts: Sadar, Companiganj, Subamachar, Hatiya; 1 upazila in Lakshmipur district: Ramgati; 4 upazila in Barisal district: Bakerganj, Hizia, Mehendiganj, Muladi; 4 upazila in Patuakhali district: Galachipa, Dashmina, Kalapara, Buuphal.

The project has four broad components: A Infrastructure Development: (i) Market Management Strengthening, (ii) Market Infrastructure, (iii) Transport Infrastructure; B.

Production and Market Group Development: (i) Group Formation and Support, (ii) Support for Marketable Crops, (iii) Support for Income Generating Activities; C. Rural Enterprise Development; D. Policy, Institutional and Management Support: (i) Policy Dialogue, (ii) Project Management, (iii) Monitoring and Evaluation.

The project will employ a Technical Assistance (TA) team to provide specialist assistance to the Project Management Unit (PMU). This includes specialists in Engineering Design & Supervision, Market & Institutional Development, Gender & Sociology, Monitoring & Evaluation and two training & NGO coordinators based in the zonal offices. The services include support in the preparation of Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWPB), Design & Technical Specification, Financial Statement, bid document and Project Implementation Manual (PIM); market and institutional activities; training and NGO coordination; gender and social issues; monitoring and evaluation of NGOs activities and other project activities; supervision & monitoring of the construction of various infrastructures like 70 numbers of hat bazar/markets, improvement and upgrading of about 440 km union and village roads, improvement of 40 boat landing and providing other specialized support.

The Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information with documentary evidence indicating that they are qualified to perform the services. The application will include: (i) details of the organization; (ii) brochures; (iii) description of similar works carried out by firms/associate firms during the last 5 years; (iv) experience in similar and other projects; (v) availability of appropriate skills among payroll staff; (vi) financial statements like balance sheet, audit report for the last 3 years; (vii) availability of logistics necessary to perform the assignment etc. Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications. The interested from must submit 5 (five) copies of the applications along with the documents mentioned above. It is expected that the service will be required for 78 months starting in the last quarter of 2006.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the Public Procurement Regulations-2003 and the procedures issued by GOB and "Guidelines for the procurement of goods, works and consulting services under IFAD loans and grants (revised April 2004)".
