Paul Scholes said his 500th game for Manchester United was "not much different" from any other after scoring in a 2-0 win against Liverpool. The shy midfielder revealed he remained unaffected by the pre-match ceremony in which he received a plaque from club great Sir Bobby Charlton.

"It was quite special," Scholes told Sky Sports. "But whether you're playing your 500th game or your first game, playing for Man United is a big thing, so it doesn't really make that much difference.

"Just to get the win is the most important thing."

Scholes struck his 132rd goal for the club six minutes before the break as he was left unmarked by the visitors and scored from close range to claim his first Premiership goal since December.

"I hadn't scored for a while as you probably know," he said.
