

JCD men beat BCL leader on charge of mugging

A leader of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) was injured as Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activists of Jahangirnagar University (JU) beat him up on Friday night for his alleged involvement in mugging on the campus.

A group of JCD activists led by Sohel beat up Hasibul Haque Bhuiyan Sajib, joint secretary of BCL, in front of Shaheed Salam Barkat hall at 11:00pm when he was returning to his dormitory.

Sajib and Shafiqul Azam Chisty, organising secretary of BCL, allegedly snatched Tk 600 from Reza, a student of Dhaka University (DU), who came to visit his friend Johnson, a student of English department at JU, on November 1. Johnson himself identified the two BCL leaders as snatchers to the journalists and political leaders.

Johnson on behalf of the victim submitted written complaints to the university proctor and to the BCL demanding punishment to those involved. BCL issued show cause notices on the accused following the complaint.

"We have requested the victim to come and identify the accused. Action will be taken after having direct version of the incident from the victim," said Mahmud Naser Joni, general secretary of JU BCL.
