A sub-contractor was shot dead by extortionists for refusal to pay tolls in the city yesterday. Mustafizur Rahman Sharif, 25, of

who had Kawser then left the place but returned soon with a gang of around 15 men and sprayed bullets on Sharif Kawser which hit his chest and head.

The gang then fled away. Sharif was rushed to Dhaka Medical College and Hospital where the doctors declared him dead.

Regrets Dr Milon's mother

Leaders and workers of different political parties and socio-cultural organisations yesterday paid tributes to Shaheed Dr Shamsul Alam Khan Milon on the occasion of his 16th death anniversary. They placed wreaths at Milon's

They placed wreaths at Milon's grave on the premises of Dhaka Medical College and at Milon Memorial in front of the Teacher-Student Centre. Dr Milon, then joint secretary general of Bangladesh Medical Association (BMA), was shot dead in 1990 during the anti-Ershad movement.

Speaking at a BMA discussion on the occasion, Selina Aktar, mother of Dr Milon, said his sacrifice had led to the mass upsurge, resulting in the fall of Ershad government.

But it is regrettable that the two major political parties, who jointly launched the movement against the autocratic ruler at that time, are now trying to take the same person into their folds only to win the elections, she said.
