Foreign liquor seized

Members of Bangladesh Coast Guard in a drive seized smuggled foreign liquor worth over Tk 25 lakh from a boat at Karnaphuli estuary in the port city early yesterday.

The Coast Guard men seized the abandoned boat and recovered 943 bottles of foreign liquor of different brands worth Tk 25.45 lakh.

Sources said the Coast Guard members intercepted a boat for its suspicious movement at the estuary at around 1:00am.

The seized liquor included dry jin of Myanmar and Ram of London, sources said.
