A carpenter sustained bomb injuries while trying to catch robbers in the city yesterday.

He was identified as Tapan Sarkar, 35.

The locals at Kathaldiya village under Badda Police Station encircled a gang of 10-

12 robbers while they were trying to flee with their booties from a house at around 2:30am, said the police.

The robbers then threw bombs at the villagers leaving Tapan hurt by bomb splinters.

He was admitted to Dhaka Medical College and Hospital.

Robbery at city house
