Tabith was not present at the campaign event, he said.

Yesterday, Tabith campaigned in Uttar Badda, Satarkul Road, Padardia, Beraid and Kuriel areas.

Meanwhile, BNP mayor candidate for Dhaka South City Corporation Ishraque Hossain also alleged that the EC is not taking action against those who are violating the electoral code of conduct.

Ishraque was speaking to journalists at a campaigning event in Dhanomdi.

"There are magistrates and presiding officers to look after the issue. We are doing our part by filing complaints with the commission. But we're yet to see any action from them," he alleged.

Contacted, DNCC Returning officer Abul Kashem said, "BNP submitted a letter over safety concerns and we have sent it to the police commissioner already. Besides, I have visited different wards and observed that electoral environment is festive and competitive."

Regarding the complaints of assault, he said, "I had sent a magistrate to the spot after receiving the complaint. We could not verify that it happened. We're doing our job and trying our best to ensure a fair environment for all."

Yesterday, Awami League mayor candidate for DNCC Atiqul Islam campaigned in Farmgate, Begunbari and Tejgaon areas while the party's mayor candidate for DSCC Barrister Sheikh Fazle Noor Taposh met with prospective voters in Dholaipara area.

This correspondent, however, could not reach them for comments despite repeated phone calls to their mobile phones.

Raushan Ershad, who was made JP's chief patron at the party's ninth council on December 28, skipped the council as "she was unhappy with her new post", said insiders.

Raushan, widow of HM Ershad, was elected for the top -- albeit ornamental -- post unopposed.

GM Quader was elected chairman of the party unopposed at the council.

Several top leaders close to Raushan told this correspondent Raushan wanted to become the party chairperson in absence of her husband.

"Quader bhai's move to give her [Raushan] the ceremonial and powerless post didn't please her," said a presidium member of the party, wishing anonymity.

Along with the chief patron post, the party during its council also introduced eight new posts of additional secretary general and seven new posts of co-chairperson.

After the council, Quader nominated Anisul Islam Mahmud, Mujibur Haque Chunnu, Ruhul Amin Hawlader, Ziauddin Ahmed Bablu and Kazi Firoz Rashid to the posts of co-chairman in a bid to pacify a section of the party's top leaders who are loyal to Raushan.

Through this move, the JP chief also wanted to tighten his grip on the party.

"But Raushan's latest move proved that Anisul, Chunnu, Hawlader and a section of other leaders of the party still remain with Raushan," said Maj (ret'd) Khaled Akhter.

After the demise of Ershad on July 14 last year, both Raushan and Quader were at loggerheads over becoming the party chairperson and opposition leader. Later, Quader was declared party chairman, an appointment opposed by Raushan's faction.

Supporters of Raushan and GM Quader -- after several meetings in September last year -- came to an understanding that Quader would remain the chairperson, while Raushan would be the opposition leader.

24kg gold recovered from plane

Customs intelligence yesterday seized 24 gold bars weighing 24 kilogrammes from an aircraft of Biman Bangladesh Airlines at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport.

A team of Customs Intelligence and Investigation Directorate (CIID) conducted a drive at flight BG-85 at the airport around 7:45pm, said Shahidul Islam, director general of CIID.

After searching the plane, the team recovered 24 gold bars -- each weighing one kg -- wrapped in black scotch tape, were hidden inside the handles of four seats of business class in the aircraft, the customs official said.

Market price of the gold is estimated at around Tk 17 crore, Shahidul added.

CIID officials were yet to know who were carrying the gold bars.

besiege the Election Office in Agargaon today if their demand was not met within the deadline.

The protests came after the High Court on Tuesday rejected a writ petition filed for shifting the date of two Dhaka city elections.

On December 22, the Election Commission announced that elections to the two Dhaka city corporations will be held on January 30. Earlier, the education ministry on December 2 fixed January 29 as a public holiday for Saraswati Puja.

Ducsu vice-president Nurul Haque Nur, who went to his office yesterday, 24 days after an attack on him and his followers, alleged that the election date was set on the day of Puja intentionally to create chaos. The polls cannot be held on the day of Puja in non-communal Bangladesh, he said.

NO SCOPE TO CHANGE DATE'
Meanwhile, Election Commission Secretary Md Alamgir yesterday said students are "protesting without understanding," and there is no scope to change the polls date.

"January 30 is a suitable time for holding the elections. There is no scope to bring the date forward or defer it. Many are protesting without understanding as they are young. They will understand in some days that it's unwise to protest," said the election commission secretary in response to a question while talking to journalists at

the EC office.

MOB BEATS UP MAN BRANDISHING FIREARM

Law enforcers yesterday detained a man with a firearm, after he was beaten up by protesting DU students, following an altercation in Shahbagh area.

Alif Rusdi Hasan Moon (45) was taken to Shahbagh Police Station and subsequently sent to a hospital for treatment, said police.

The incident took place when around 500 DU students were protesting, blocking the Shahbagh intersection.

"During the blockade, one man driving a black car came out of the vehicle and demanded that his car be allowed to pass through. As we refused, he pulled out a pistol and aimed it at a student's chest, which enraged students and they started beating him," said Kanjilal Toy, cultural affairs secretary of Jagannath Hall union.

Later, police intervened and rescued the man, and recovered a licensed shotgun from his car aside from the pistol, said Deputy Commissioner HM Azimul Haque of the DMP Ramna Division. He said they would investigate the issue.

Officer-in-Charge of Shahbagh Police Station Abul Hasan told The Daily Star, "The man's pregnant wife was in the car at that time, and they were going to attend a family programme." Later, police took the car to Shahbagh Police Station.

establish a zero-cost recruitment deal with Bangladesh to eliminate forced labour and avoid possible trade sanctions from the US.

Last October, the US Customs and Border Protection blocked imported goods from five companies that were accused of practicing forced labour, including Malaysian glove maker WRP Asia Pacific Sdn Bhd.

The US Customs said imported goods that are wholly produced or in part of forced labour are illegal to be imported under the US law.

The instruction came after about 2,000 of WRP Asia Pacific's migrant workers from Bangladesh and Nepal staged a three-day strike for their salaries being withheld early last year.

The blockage also took a toll on WRP Asia Pacific, as it temporarily suspended its business operations in December, and appointed interim liquidators.

In a separate press statement, Ain o Salish Kendra (ASK) -- a prominent human rights organisation -- said ASK has been demanding a ban on crossfire for a long time as it is against the constitution.

But lawmakers are demanding an illegal and inhuman act like this which is unfortunate, said the statement issued by its executive director Sheeja Hafiza.

Transparency International Bangladesh (TIB) Executive Director Iftekaruzzaman, in a press statement, said they want to consider the lawmakers' comments driven by emotion. "But how could they forget the significance of protecting human rights and establishing rule of law?" he asked.

Such a stance from policymakers will cause professional degradation among law enforcement agencies and increase people's distrust in the judiciary, he added.

Naripokkho, a women's rights organisation, in its statement said if the government wants to eradicate rape, it should ensure proper justice and uphold the culture of impunity. On the other hand, crossfires will encourage extrajudicial killings and the culture of impunity, it added.

The project was undertaken on the premise that RTI is not being applied adequately, she said. The RTI applications are not merely meant for individual needs, it also provides an idea of how far the government development programmes have achieved desired goals, the project coordinator said.

The application of RTI law would benefit both individuals and the government alike, said RIB Chairperson Shamsul Bari.

RTI not only helps achieve people's entitlement and welfare, but also effective function of the government, said Badiul Alam Majumdar, country director of The Hunger Project Bangladesh.

Shaheen Anam, executive director of Manusher Jonno Foundation and convener of RTI Forum, said nurturing more RTI activists and holding consistency in the process are both essential. "The RTI law reflects all the constitutional entitlements of citizens," she said.

"The Information Commission alone is not sufficient, a tangible role of the information ministry is equally required for achieving the goals of RTI law," she added.

Chief Information Commissioner Martuza Ahmed said the commission has its own limitations in playing an expected vibrant role.
