Despite predicaments

any interest in involving reserved seat councillors in city corporation activities, she added.

"In the last one year as a councillor, I did not get any development work from the DSCC mayor. I tried to get involved in various activities on my own," said Nazma.

"I know that I could play an important role in the projects, if given the opportunity. If we [women councillors] do not work for the people, why would they vote for us?" she said.

Nazma said they could carry out different development works for women's empowerment, if the authorities concerned supported them. "I even conducted training on sewing and knitting for the disadvantaged in my areas on my own during my one-year councillorship."

AL's Shahnaz Begum is a councillor aspirant for wards 67-69. She said she wants to work for building a drug-free society and empowering insolvent women through organising necessary funds and training programmes.

"To achieve this goal, it is very important to have the mayor's and general councillors' support," she said.

BNP councillor aspirant Farida Yesmin (ward 39, 40, 49 under Wari) said reserved seat women councillors need more power in order to work for the betterment of their respective wards.

(ward 52-54 under Kadamtali) said, "It's not easy to cover three wards within a short time. Even if we want to, we cannot conduct door-to-door campaigns like our male counterparts as we have a larger area

Mentioning lack of playgrounds in her wards, she said, "If elected, I want to work for creating more open spaces and playgrounds."

In the north, 18 women councillor candidates each from Awami League and BNP are vying for the reserved seats.

Salma Kamal, president of Pallabi Thana Mohila Awami league, is contesting for the second time in wards 2, 3, 5. Her area includes Pallabi and Brindaban areas. She is also joint secretary of Dhaka Mohanagar Mohila Awami League.

"Nearly half the voters in my area are women. I am encouraging them to vote," she said, adding that women's right to vote is imperative.

She said, "It's quite challenging to look after multiple wards. Despite various discriminations, we continue to work for people. If elected, I would like to do more for women."

Razia Sultana Etee is the incumbent councillor of wards 9-11. Her area includes Gabtoli, Kalyanpur, Darussalam and Mirpur.

The senior vice president of Darussalam Thana Mohila Awami League said, "Since

BNP-backed candidate Khaleda Alam 2001, women candidates for reserve not given any fogger machines," she said. seats are being elected, not selected. I am contesting again as I want to help women in my area.

She said it is crucial that the authorities concerned extend full support to them so that they can continue to serve people in the best possible way.

"Our responsibility is in no way less than our male counterparts. We actually cover more area than them. That's why I don't like to call us reserved seat councillors," she

"If elected, I will continue to work for women's empowerment. But at the same time, I know the limitations we face, so I am not promising anything grand. I wish to set up a training centre for widows and poor women, where they will learn how to sew and knit for free," she added.

About the challenges women candidates face, she said, "During campaign, we need to cover many areas in a short span of time. I had to communicate with people through mike for hours in multiple areas. Now doctors are telling me not to talk much and rest my voice, otherwise my vocal cord may get damaged.

"But as a pubic representative, how can I not speak to people?'

Stressing the need for more support from the city corporation, she said, "During the dengue outbreak, I had to initiate awareness campaign with my own funds as we were

'A CHANGE IN POLITICAL MINDSET, SYSTEM NEEDED' Stressing that equal participation of men

and women in running a state and decisionmaking process is imperative, Dr Fauzia Moslem, acting president of Bangladesh Mahila Parishad, said a woman councillor [from reserved seat] has to work in three ards at a time.

In this context, women councillors cannot ensure their due role in development activities as they are deprived of adequate government funds and proper working environment, she said.

Local government expert Tofail Ahmed said the current system has to be changed. He said a parliamentary system should be introduced where people will elect councillors and then the councillors will elect a mayor from themselves.

In a male-dominated society, women in reserved seats cannot exercise power properly, whereas male councillors exercise ower beyond their jurisdiction, he added.

"To empower women in the current system, one-third of the total wards should be dedicated only for women candidates, from where they will contest as councillors. Also, the wards can be changed by rotation every five years," he added.

Experts also suggested that a change in political mindset is also crucial in this

crore, said Mohammad Sidul Islam.

Of them, 5.53 crore are male and 5.42 crore female. Besides, names of 13.92 lakh voters who died were dropped from the list.

Sidul Islam said during data collection between April 24 and May 19 last year, enumerators of EC collected data of citizens who were born on or before January 1 in 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004, and the latest draft list contains names of those born on or before January 1 of 2001 and 2002.

"We will publish draft lists gradually in 2021 and 2022 with information of citizens who were born on or before January 1, 2003 and 2004; they would gradually be included in the electoral roll after reaching the age of 18," he said. The draft voter list was made available at district and

upazila election offices. People will get a chance to correct their information and file any complains about the new list by February 5. The correction and complains may include -- amending

personal information and address, excluding names of deceased persons, appeal for migration from one area to another and any objection against any newly-registered voters, said EC officials.

Officials will complete corrections and resolve the disputes by February 22, and the final list will be published on March 1.

BILL PLACED AT JS TO EXTEND DEADLINE

Meanwhile, a bill titled "Electoral Rolls (Amendment) Bill 2020" was placed in parliament yesterday, aimed at extending the deadline for updating voter lists till March 2 instead of January 31 every year.

Law Minister Anisul Huq placed the bill, which was sent to the parliamentary standing committee on the respective ministry for further scrutiny. The parliamentary standing committee on law was asked to submit its report before the House within three working days.

While placing the proposed law, the minister said the amendment was brought to the existing Electoral Rolls Act 2009 aiming to extend the timeframe till March 1, as it is difficult to update all the voter lists within only 29 days from January 2 to January 31.

According to article 11 of the existing Electoral Rolls Act 2009, there is a provision to update all voter lists from January 2 to January 31 every year. The law minister also said the cabinet meeting earlier also decided to observe national voter day on March 2 instead of March 1 every year.

TK 1.17CR COMPENSATION FOR AIR **CRASH CASUALTIES**

Yesterday, the cabinet also gave final approval to a draft law on air transportation, proposing an enhanced compensation of Tk 1.17 crore for every casualty in any air crash, while the previous amount was Tk 20,37,600, reports BSS.

"The weekly cabinet meeting gave its final nod to The Air Transport (The Montreal Convention, 1999) Act, 2020," said the cabinet secretary.

He said the amount was meant for individual victims of any air crash, dead or wounded; the law was drafted in line with the 1999 Montreal Convention, which Bangladesh endorsed the same year.

Officials familiar with the drafting process said victims of a recent crash of an aircraft belonging to a Bangladeshi private

airlines got Tk 20,37,600, which appeared minimal, prompting authorities to reassess the amount under the proposed law.

The cabinet secretary said the law also proposed payment of US \$5,734 to every passenger by every flight carrier for delays, while the amount previously was \$20.

He said the proposed law would also obligate flight carriers to compensate for missing or damaged luggage and cargo.

Anwarul said the proposed amount is \$1,381 and \$24 respectively for per kg of damaged or lost baggage and cargo; the compensation were \$20 for both the cases

The top bureaucrat said the cabinet also approved in principle draft of "The Bangladesh Travel Agencies (Registration and Control) (Amendment), Act, 2020, aimed at making their operations smooth.

day.

"The state of the state and certainly in my country -- as we look at our election coming at the end of this year -- participate in the process, which is sometimes imperfect, noisy, messy but a vitally important process," he added.
