Grameenphone launched sign-line digital care dedicated to the speech and hearing impaired on February 16, 2020, at The Westin Dhaka. It is operated by the hearing and speech impaired community.

Through this initiative,

Grameenphone has incorporated sign language based digital care service in its official website and its self-service digital care app MyGP. Furthermore, the 'Kothagulo Hariye Na Jak Shobder Obhabe' campaign will enable interested members of

the community to learn the basics of sign language through a tutorial video by sign language expert Arafat Sultana Lata. Anyone can access this sign language video tutorial from Grameenphone's official website and YouTube channel.

Samsung Bangladesh bringing Galaxy Note 10 Lite

Galaxy Note 10 Lite model is now available at a price point of BDT 55,999/-. On the rear camera, the Galaxy Note10 Lite boasts of a triple camera system comprising of three 12MP sensors. There is a Dual Pixel OIS (Optical Image Specialization) 12MP wide camera with f/1.7 aperture, a 12MP ultra-wide sensor with 123-degree and f/2.2 aperture, and a 12MP telephoto sensor with auto-focus and f/2.4 aperture. Camera features of the



Galaxy Note10 Lite include Super Steady mode and Live Focus mode. For selfies, the device offers a 32MP resolution punch-hole camera with f/2.2 aperture.

Samsung Galaxy Note10 Lite is equipped with a 6.7-inch Super AMOLED Plus Infinity-O display with FHD+ (Full High Definition) (2400x1080p) resolution and an aspect ratio of 20:9. It is powered by 10nm 64-bit Exynos 9810 octa-core processor paired with 8GB RAM, 128GB internal storage, and supports storage of up to 1TB. The device is backed by a 4500mAh battery with fast charge support. The devices will be available in Aura Black and Aura Glow.



Facebook's new app is aimed at the creative minded

Facebook's NPE Team has introduced a new experimental app called Hobbi, a photo and video sharing app designed to document personal projects and hobbies.

The app is visually similar to Pinterest, but is designed to be less of an idea pin-board and more of an archive for creators, with the main purpose being to help hobbyists

organize photos of their own projects into themed collections, and allowing them to document their progress over time. The app also lacks any major social networking component, beyond the ability to create video highlight reels to share externally.

Hobbi is currently available for download on iOS in a few selected countries.

35 free public Wi-Fi zones in Cox's Bazar

35 public Wi-Fi zones have been set up to provide free internet services in Cox's Bazar. The residents and tourists, nearly 34,000 people, in Cox's Bazar will now be able to access e-government services and internet from the free Wi-Fi zones with maximum 20 Mbps speed from their mobile phones, pads or laptops without any limitations at a time.

Bangladesh Computer Council (BCC) is implementing the 'Digital Sylhet City Project' with the development of 'Public Wi-Fi Zone' in Sylhet and Cox's Bazar to facilitate people with easy access to government services along with other internet services at free of cost. Huawei has provided the cloud-managed public Wi-Fi solutions for this project.
